In September 2010, a new playground was constructed in Hunting Park, thanks to a donation by KaBoom!, a national non-profit organization with an innovative community-build model to bring together business and community interests to construct new playgrounds, skate parks and sports fields across North America. Along with the financial and volunteer contributions by the Home Depot Foundation and with the assistance of volunteers, KaBoom! helped transform a space at 9th and Hunting Park Avenue to a vibrant neighborhood-gathering place in the course of just one day.

On Friday, November 4, 2011 GMC and United Way of Southeastern Pennsylvania will install the *United Way Healthy Kids Zone- Driven by GMC* playground supplied by GameTime. This is the second playground to be installed in Hunting Park as part of the Revitalization. This playground is for older youth and is located near the community garden and farmer's market at the intersection of Old York Road and Hunting Park Avenue.
